

6257 Copy Vending & Account Terminal



Description

The Infineer 6257 combines the functionality of a debit system and an account card system in one terminal. Users are divided by card type into paying and non-paying or account customers.

Paying customers may be issued a disposable card or a revaluable card. Cards can be encoded to carry cash or copy values. The revaluable cards can be recharged by an authorised member of staff at the copier terminal or alternatively using a 9255 encoder. Self-service revaluation can take place at an Infineer Card Centre where the user inserts notes and coins and the value is written to the card.

In the case of account customers, for example members of staff, cards are encoded with an initial value, which may act as a limit if required. As the user takes copies these may be allocated to a particular cost centre by entering a code. Account cards may also be PIN protected. When the copying allocation runs out, then the card must be revalued by an authorised member of staff at the terminal itself or 9255 encoder. The terminal can accommodate up to 2660 account holders and 100 groups.

The 6257 has four pricelines and provides on-screen, printed audits or laptop data collection. It is an ideal solution for education sites where students pay for copies in advance using a debit card, while members of staff are given an account card against which any copies taken are logged.
