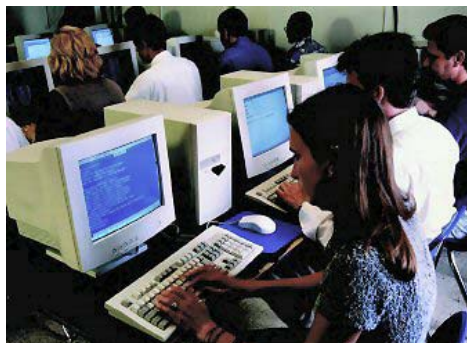


## “EasyTime” PC Time Charging Software (SL021)



### Functional Overview

The EasyCard EasyTime PC time control software is ideally suited to owners of Internet Cafes or any establishment that wants to recover the cost of providing expensive computer resources.

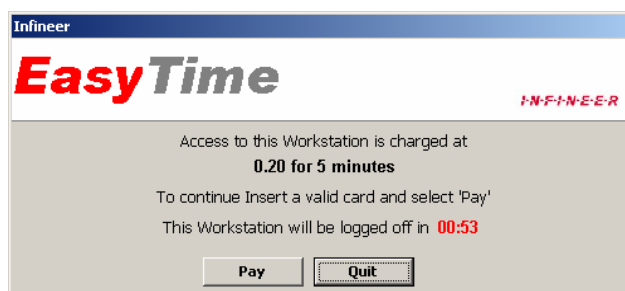
The PC Time Charging software comprises an Administrator Application and a Client Application. The client software communicates to the central database over a Local Area Network (LAN). Each client workstation runs a service application that monitors the time spent at the PC. The client software uses the attached terminal to charge for the time period the user is logged on for. The payment amount is deducted from the card that is inserted into the terminal.

Status information, pricing and transactional data is stored centrally at an administration PC. This database is managed by the Administrator application, which allows the user to edit pricing and run audit reports.

It is even possible to run the client application and the administrator application on the same workstation in a stand-alone environment. This feature facilitates charging at stand-alone PCs as the password protection facility ensures that users paying for time at the PC cannot access or edit the pricing structures etc.

### Client Application

After a user has logged onto a workstation the client application displays a welcome message and details of the charge rate and duration of the current session. The dialogue also displays a countdown of the grace period. When the grace period reaches '0' the workstation will be logged off automatically.




The user has the option to 'Pay' or 'Quit'. Selecting 'Pay' will attempt to deduct the amount specified from the "cash purse" of the card inserted into the terminal attached to the workstation. If the terminal is unable to deduct from the card the Pay function will fail and the user will be logged off at the end of a definable grace period. Selecting 'Quit' logs the workstation off immediately.

After successful payment the welcome dialogue disappears and the time remaining dialogue is displayed in the top corner of the screen. The dialogue counts down until the end of the session.

At the end of a session the welcome dialog re-appears and prompts for another payment. The user has until the end of the grace period to select 'Pay' or 'Quit'.

### Administrator Application

The Administrator Application provides a facility for defining prices and promotional schemes such as "Happy Hour Pricing". This application also allows the administrator to view the status of all networked terminals and provides basic audit reports. The reports available detail the name of the PC where the transaction took place, as well as the transaction date and time and the amount charged.
