

67 Series Pcounter Pro SMS Terminal with Proximity Card Log On



Description

The *Infiner 67 Series Pcounter Pro (Proximity) terminals* are copy release terminals designed for connection to any make or model of network-enabled copier/multi-function device, providing the ultimate in flexibility and control for those organisations wishing to manage, control, monitor or charge-back against copies made.

In addition, a proximity card can be used to log on to the terminal, the first time a card is used the terminal will ask the cardholder for their network user name and password. Once this has been inputted the software will create a relationship between the card and the cardholder's Pcounter account. The next time the card is presented at the terminal the user will only have to enter their password to access the system.

So if you currently use a proximity card for access control or security you can now use it to access *Pcounter*. This can significantly cut down queues in busy environments or make log on easier in establishments that use extended user names.

67 Series terminals have four price lines that can be used to charge for different paper sizes. The terminal accesses *Pcounter* online accounts to provide a payment source for any copies taken. The user inputs their identification, username, password and client code/project number (optional), via the SMS style keypad and the account balance is transmitted via a TCP/IP network to the terminal. On receipt of the account balance, the copy device is enabled and the user can copy as normal. On completion, the *Pcounter* account is updated to reflect the cost of all copies made.

Operation is achieved by an *Infiner* TCP/IP service installed on a server that facilitates all communications between the copy release terminal and the *Pcounter* software.

Secure Print Release

The terminal can also release print jobs, queued by *Pcounter* users, as an alternative to a dedicated *Pcounter Release Station* using the *Pcounter Secure Print Release* option. A terminal is placed next to a specific network printer and an association is created between the two in the software. The user can then print as normal but the print job is not called and printed at the associated printer until the user logs in at the terminal.

Account Mode

The terminal can also facilitate cost recovery or cost management by recording each job against a Client and Job code instead of accessing an on-line **Pcounter** account.

For corporate customers where the use of proximity access control cards is common, the 67 Series terminal's quick and efficient log on allows the staff members name to be recorded in addition to the Client and Job code giving an extra layer of reporting depth without sacrificing efficiency.
