

8652 & Uniwell POS Terminal



Description

The Infeer 8652 terminal will operate as a payment device in conjunction with the SX and TX range of Uniwell POS terminals. The solution is ideally suited to cafeteria or club environments where a membership or voucher scheme is in place.

The 8652 terminals support TCP/IP network communications permitting robust, real-time audit reporting and integration with existing LAN/WAN architectures.

Using the ChipNet3 software the administrator can set up the device remotely, configure Hotkeys and manage the PLU list. Any changes that are made are fed down to the point of sale automatically. You can even configure each point of sale individually to suit different locations.

You can restrict the terminal to accept purchases from the "cash" purse only, or offer the choice of using the special features of the ChipNet3 Discount, Subsidy and Allowance purses as well as in conjunction with ChipNet3 Value and Meal Plans. The Uniwell POS can be programmed with a Add-to-Card facility to allow the operator the option to revalue cards and the combination also supports split tendering (combined cash and card payment).

Your ChipNet3 Dealer can give you advice on the current Uniwell model numbers that are compatible with ChipNet3. All you need to do is make the necessary changes in the Uniwell set up menu and the 8652 plugs straight in.

In addition to full reporting through ChipNet, all of the standard Uniwell Point-of-Sale reports are available and can be printed through a receipt printer. Card sales and other activity such as revaluations and use of the special ChipNet features such as discount etc. will be clearly identified.
